We have been noticing trash & recycle bins that are visible. Per the restrictions and city code, trash and recycle bins must not be visible from the street from either the front or sides of your house with, of course, the exception of the evening before trash day and trash day. To avoid penalties from the HOA and the city start placing your trash and recycle bins out of sight.

Per the restrictions and city code any





vehicle parked in a driveway or on the city street must be in compliance with city code. No unlicensed vehicle, not limited to trailers or other equipment intended to be moved over public streets, may be parked outside in a driveway or street. No trailer homes, not limited to travel trailers, mobile homes. recreational vehicles, watercraft or trailers of any kind may be parked outside of a fully enclosed garage for more than (72) hours. If a travel trailer, or portable-ondemand storage/waste container. recreational vehicle or watercraft is to be temporarily parked in a driveway, the Board must be contacted for a temporary waiver of this restriction. To avoid any penalties from the HOA and the city please comply with these restrictions.
