**IMPORTANT REMINDERS** ... Please maintain your property, this includes fences. Trim your bushes and trees so they are not obstructing sidewalks. Many homeowners make changes to the outside of their homes (paint color, fences, out buildings, etc.) Avoid headaches and extra costs, have your plans reviewed by the board first. You are always welcome to attend a board meeting to discuss your plans, as well. Make sure you do not need a permit with the city also.

Any vehicle parked in a driveway or on the city street must be in compliance with city code. No unlicensed vehicle, not limited to trailers or other equipment intended to be moved over public streets, may be parked outside in a driveway or street. No trailer homes, not limited to travel trailers, mobile homes, recreational vehicles, watercraft or trailers of any kind may be parked outside of a fully enclosed garage for more than (72) hours. If a travel trailer, or portable-on-demand storage/waste container, recreational vehicle or watercraft is to be temporarily parked in a driveway, the Board must be contacted for a temporary waiver of this restriction.



New ordinance for the city of Lee's Summit: Your vehicle cannot block the sidewalk for pedestrians. The city will not be actively looking for this violation but if they do see a vehicle blocking the sidewalk you will be ticketed.

Please keep our neighborhood safe for our children, pets and protect yourself. OBSERVE the 25 m.p.h. speed limit!!!

<u>Please respect your fellow neighbors' property and do not forget to pick up what your dog leaves behind</u> when out walking your dog. It's the right thing to do!!! Obey the leash laws!!! This applies to cats also!!!

Please take your trash bins and recycle bin in as soon as possible after trash pick-up. The restrictions and city code require your trash and recycle bin to be out of sight. To help avoid any unnecessary fines from the city or the association please store your trash and recycle bins out of sight. They can not be visible from the street except on Monday evening and trash day which is on Tuesday's.





The 4<sup>th</sup> of July is just around the corner ... Please be a courteous neighbor and clean up after your fireworks displays and any debris left behind! Firework usage per city code is July 2-3 10 a.m.-11p.m. July 4<sup>th</sup> 10 a.m.-midnight. Remember to get your free permit from the city and be safe! Reminder that <u>QUIET HOURS</u> ... FOR ALL CITY NEIGHBORHOODS ARE FROM 11 p.m. to 7a.m. If you are having a party that goes into the night, please talk to your neighbors or go inside after 11p.m. to be considerate of your neighbors. This also includes mowing your lawn at a reasonable hour not to disturb your neighbor. We can have a peaceful neighborhood if everyone abides by this.
