

Please maintain your property.... This includes fences, bushes, trees. Homeowners' making changes to the outside of their homes (paint color, fences, out buildings, etc.) Avoid headaches and extra cost by having your plans reviewed by the HOA board and the City of Lee's Summit. In the winter season there is not an ordinance requiring property owners to clear sidewalks. However, property owners are encouraged to clear snow for safety reasons.

Dog waste and Cats Please respect your fellow neighbors property and do not forget to pick up what your dog leaves behind when you are out walking your dog. It's the right thing to do! Obey the leash laws! This applies to cats also!

Trash and Recycle Bins Per the restrictions and city code, trash and recycle bins must not be visible from the street from either the front or sides of your house with, of course, the exception of the evening before trash day and trash day. To avoid penalties from the HOA and the city start placing your trash and recycle bins out of sight. Please avoid headaches and extra cost by obeying the restriction.

Quiet Hours For all city neighborhoods are from 11 p.m. to 7 a.m. If you are having a party at night, be considerate of your neighbors.

Spring Break this year is March 16th to March 20th. Children will be outside playing. Please be careful and obey the speed limit which is 25 mph.

Reminder.... don't leave garage doors open, even if you're out working in the yard. Once the weather warms up, we see an increase in open garage door burglaries. Also, keep an eye out for your neighbors and if you see they have left their garage door open at night, either contact them or call the police. This is the time of year for thefts from unlocked vehicles so now is the time to remind folks to lock doors and take valuables with them. Especially in neighborhoods during the overnight hours. Finally, call 911 or the Lee's Summit non-emergency dispatch at 969-7390 to report any problems, even with solicitors. Solicitors must be licensed with the City of Lee's Summit.

Any vehicle parked in a driveway or on the city street must be in compliance with city code. No unlicensed vehicle, not limited to trailers or other equipment intended to be moved over public streets, may be parked outside in a driveway or street. No trailer homes, not limited to travel trailers, mobile homes, recreational vehicles, watercraft or trailers of any kind may be parked outside of a fully enclosed garage for more than (72) hours. If a travel trailer, or portable-ondemand storage/waste container, recreational vehicle or watercraft is to be temporarily parked in a driveway, the Board must be contacted for a temporary waiver of this restriction.
